

Dear Parents and Carers

Under the guidance of The Department of Education and Public Health we have had to close the Reception and Year 1 classes.

Two members of staff have contracted COVID 19. We wish them both a speedy and complete recovery.

The children will return to School on Tuesday 20th October. The teaching staff will provide on-line learning each day.

The Reception and Year 1 classrooms will be deep cleaned over the two week period.

There have been some misconceptions on some parents' Facebook pages so School wishes to clarify the situation. The Reception and Year 1 pupils are in self isolation, however the Department of Education guidance states 'your household can continue normal activities provided your child does not develop symptom's within the 14 day self isolation period'.

This means that siblings can come to School and parents/carers can carry out their normal daily routines. If the Reception/Year 1 child becomes ill with COVID 19 the whole family will have to go into self isolation (not leaving the household) for 14 days.
